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INTRODUCTION

There is a road on which we can travel where
all things are added to us;
All our needs are met, we are divinely led, and the
supply for every demand is available to us.
This path has been vastly untravelled
because of one simple truth
that has been so very misunderstood.

A well-known book, who many live their lives by, tells us to “seek first the kingdom of God and all these things will be added unto us.” This is an incredible promise, based on only one condition. There is a way in which we can live that enables us to have “all things” given to us when we need them, if we will but “seek first the kingdom of God.”

In order to understand this text, there are two questions we need to ask? What are “all things”, and what is this “kingdom of God” we are asked to seek? When we discover the answers to these two questions, we will discover a new and exciting way in which to live.

Firstly, what are “all things?” According to the Bible that teaches this truth, “all things” are what we will eat and drink, and what we will wear. In other words, our basic human needs. We have been promised that we will never lack anything we need, so long as we seek first the kingdom of God. So we must now answer the second question. What is the kingdom of God?

WHAT IS THE KINGDOM OF GOD?

Firstly, let us look at what it is not. It has been taught for many years, that the kingdom of God is the Christian church and often a specific church. Growing up in these churches, I was told that if I put all of my effort and energy into seeking first that kingdom, in others words, working for that church, or building that ministry, then God would reward me by giving to me the things that I needed for my basic survival (like what I should eat, drink and wear.) This idea of receiving back according to what I had given may have been true on some level, but not because I was first “seeking the kingdom of God”. If miracles did occur in this way, it was because I was following the universal law of sowing and reaping; as I give to others, so it shall be given back to me.

The message of seeking first the kingdom of God, and having all of our needs met as a result, has nothing to do with the law of sowing and reaping. In fact, it is a simple message that is explained

to us very clearly in this book we so value and live by. When we understand what "seeking first the kingdom of God" means, we find ourselves on a path of joy and peace and simple trust. A path that is free from worry and anxiety and endless hours of unnecessary work and effort. This path... the path where all things are added to us... is a miraculous one and it is available to everyone who seeks it. When we seek it, we shall find it. In fact, we are told that *whosoever* seeks this path... finds it.

Thankfully, we have been told very clearly *what* the kingdom of God is. Romans 4:12 states that the kingdom of God is *righteousness, peace and joy*. Righteousness simply means that we are innocent, guiltless and blameless. It means that we are one with our creator and therefore we are in right standing with him. We can call our creator whatever we desire... the universe, infinite intelligence, infinite love, omnipotent power, God.. whatever name we desire to give the powerful force of creation is okay with him. He is not insecure and does not worry about what we call him.

The fact is, we are part of this powerful being, we are one with him. Our fathering Theologians wrestled with this for years and concluded that we are "of the same substance" as God. This is recorded in the Nicene Creed and is accepted by every denomination who adopts that creed as their foundations of faith. This means that if God is "okay", that makes us "okay"! This is what the kingdom of God is. This is what we are to "seek first". That place where we experience a complete understanding of being okay just the way we are! A place where we know peace and joy as a result of this understanding and live out of that realisation that we are perfect creations, at one with God. When we understand that God is not a human being, or anything like a human being who sits on a throne demanding that we live by certain rules and regulations and that we must obey these rules or he will be mad with us, we begin to understand the kingdom of God.

The kingdom of God is a creative power. Paul wrote to the Corinthian church declaring that "the kingdom of God is not just talk, it is living by God's power." (1 Cor 4:20) The kingdom of God is a place where we are living in total peace and joy, knowing that our creator is working together with us and for us. It is a place of the miraculous, where his power is demonstrated towards us by "adding to us" everything we need.

WHERE IS THE KINGDOM OF GOD?

Jesus gave us the answer to this question when he walked on the earth. He taught this message: The kingdom of God is within you. The kingdom of God is within us! In fact, when the Pharisees asked him when the kingdom of God would come (as they were expecting a physical kingdom), he told them to stop looking for it. "It does not come with observation," he said. "It is already within you." We will not find this kingdom outside of ourselves. It is not a physical place. It is not a church organisation, not an institution and not something that we are to look forward to that will one day be available to us. It is already here. It is within us. This righteousness - the knowing that we are one with Infinite Intelligence, one with the universe, one with God, and that makes us okay - is within us. This place of peace and joy... is already within us, we simply need to enter into it. (Luke 17:21)

HOW DO WE ENTER THIS KINGDOM?

How do we gain access to this place of peace and joy within; to this place where we have a complete understanding that we are good and we are okay? This place where "all things are added to us?" Again, Jesus gave us the answer, "Unless we become like little children, we cannot enter the kingdom of God." It is only through trust and simple faith, believing that we are one with God, believing that we are good and that he is not mad with us, but that his love is available to us right now. This

is how we “enter” the kingdom of God. Through faith. The kingdom of God is not a physical place, it is a spiritual place where we stop trying to figure things out in our minds, stop trying to work for the approval of others, and stop worrying about our basic needs in life. It is the place where we allow the answers to our problems, and the things we need, to come to us.

The kingdom of God is the place where, by believing, we simply ask and receive. It is the place where all our needs are met and we are living in the realm of miracles. It is the place where we do not need to strive, worry, or be anxious about what we will eat or drink, because Infinite Intelligence knows that we need these things. And when we stop worrying, but seek first this peace and joy within... a relationship with the God we are at one with... when we seek first a relationship of trust with the creative power within us, then we find that all things are added to us.

The kingdom of God is also not simply declaring words of affirmation as many prosperity messages teach us, but it is trusting in the power behind the words. It is believing that we have a creative force within us to carry the words we speak out into the atmosphere and accomplish “that” for which they have been sent.

In our English language every letter has a sound. Some of these sounds are “voiced” and some are “unvoiced”. The unvoiced sounds, such as the letters “f” and “h” have no vibration. The voiced sounds, such as the letter “v” and many other consonants, create a vibration when we speak them. Every word includes voiced consonants and therefore they carry a vibration. When we speak words, they go out into the atmosphere along a certain vibrational frequency. When we speak negative words of sadness and pain, that is what is accomplished in our lives. When we speak words from a place of faith and trust, they carry the vibrational force of

the creative power within us. This is the highest vibrational state as it comes directly from “the kingdom of God” within us.

Words and thoughts are a tremendous vibratory force, shaping our lives and our circumstances. In fact, when we know and understand the power of our words there is nothing too great for us to accomplish. When Moses asked this creative force his name, he replied, “I am that I am.”

I am, as we know from the English language is the verb “to be” and it means “to exist”. I exist. I am. What God was saying was, tell them I simply exist. I have heard their cries for help and my mighty power is available to free them from their lives of bondage and slavery and give them life.

There is a way in which we can live where all things are added to us. A way of life that is full of peace and joy, a life of miracles. This way of life does not require us to strive endlessly, speaking affirmations and visualising daily (although those are good things to do and I advocate doing them. But I advocate doing them from a place of rest, not work.) The kingdom of God is a place where the “right words” are given to us (by a divine lead we often call intuition) and as we speak these words, their creative power goes out to achieve the desired result. It is a place of intimacy with our creator, hearing directly from him, and it is available to everyone.

IT IS GOD'S GOOD PLEASURE TO GIVE US THE KINGDOM.

The Bible tells us... it is our Father's good pleasure to give us this kingdom! God so desires that we find this place of peace and freedom, where all things are added, that it is his “good pleasure” to give it to us!

In this course you will discover how to access this place of peace. How to find peace and joy and

live in the realm of the miraculous. This is not a place of “prosperity thinking”, where we hope for BMW’s, First Class upgrades and all other material possession we believe will make us happy. This is a place of stillness and tranquillity, pure joy and bliss, that we will experience as we cultivate a relationship with the creative power within us, and out of that place, out of that relationship, we simply need to ask and receive, because we will already understand that our creator knows what we need and is willing to provide it for us.

I invite you to come on this journey with me, and seek this place. Seek it above all else. Seek it first, before anything else. Before any activity. Before any work. We have been assured that when we seek this kingdom... we will find it. And when we find this place we will know that all we need to do is simply ask for the answer to every problem and for the supply for every need, and we will never be disappointed because our creator, when we approach him in simply faith and trust, will never let us down.

It is my hope that you enjoy this course and allow the truth to set you free. God is always calling us into freedom. It is always his desire to set us free. Free from worry, free from anxiety, free from stress and free from the need for approval or any other addiction we have in life. It is his desire for us to be free to be one with him... in our thinking and in our very existence. It is possible to experience this kind of life, and it is my desire, that as you progress through this course... you will find it.
